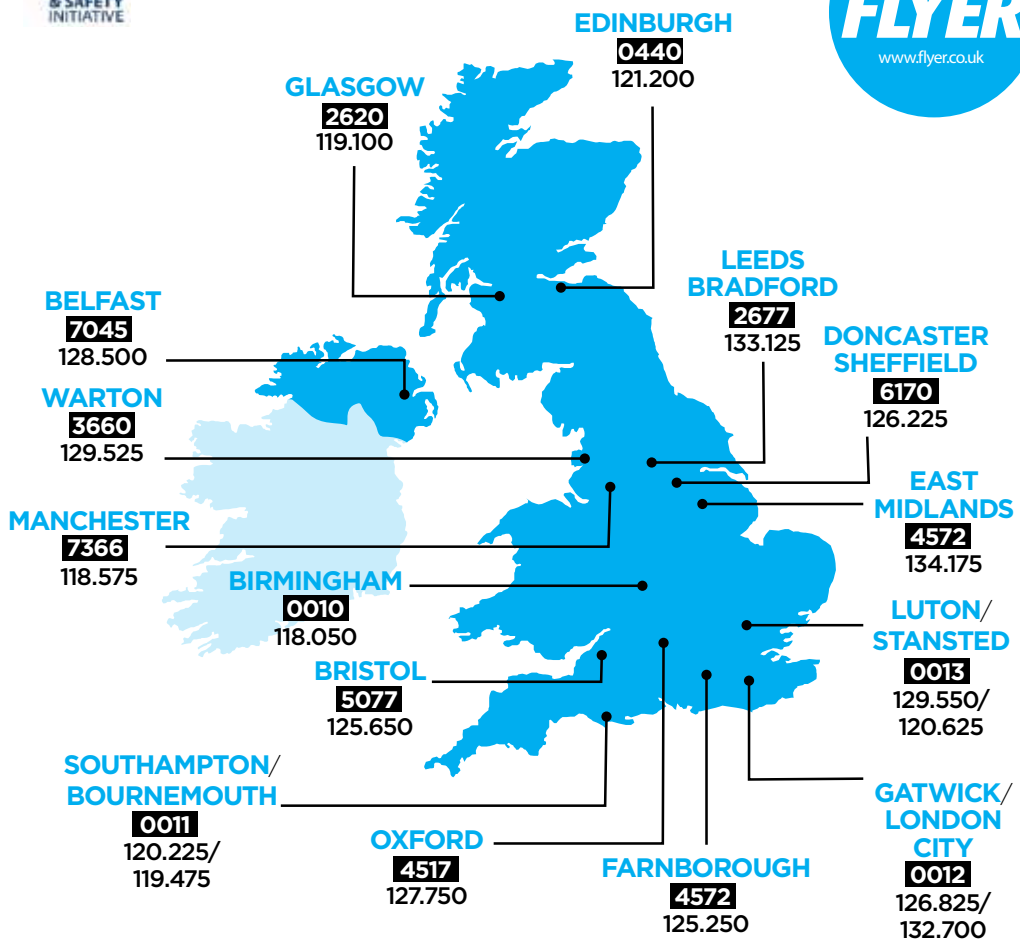


Transponder - if you've got it, *squawk* it

LISTENING SQUAWKS

Set your transponder to the code allotted to the airspace and then listen out on the corresponding radio frequency.

If ATC wants to contact you, it can either use your aircraft registration (if your transponder is Mode S equipped) or by identifying your position (if your transponder is Mode A or C).

When you leave the area or change frequency, change the transponder code back to 7000.

Remember, a squawk code does NOT clear you into controlled airspace, and you are NOT receiving an ATC service.
